V. Continuation: Students admitted to the program option must maintain a 3.0 undergraduate GPA, be in good standing with the College, and take the required professional education courses as part of their undergraduate study (EDUC 301, EDUC 310 and EDUC F65; Special Education students may also take EDUC 425)

VI. Elevation to Master's Level: In order to elevate to the Master's level, students must (1) earn a 3.0 GPA in the professional education courses completed as an undergraduate and maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA, (2) graduate with their Bachelor's degree from W&M and (3) submit scores for the GRE (Graduate Record Examination) that meet the admissions guidelines for the SOE. The MAT (Miller Analogies Test) may be substituted for admission to the special education program. GRE/MAT scores must be submitted prior to January 15 of the senior year; however, applicants are strongly encouraged to submit scores as early as the spring of their junior year.

VII. Continuation in the Master's Program: Once elevated to the Master's portion of the program, students will enroll as full-time students and follow the continuation and program rules of the Master of Arts in Education (M.A.Ed.) in Curriculum & Instruction. Students will complete the regular sequence of courses, *excluding* EDUC F11, EDUC F12 and EDUC F65. These courses or their accepted equivalents will have been satisfied in the undergraduate portion of the program.
