Educators who embrace historical truths recognize the **"danger of the single story"** that so often surfaces in popular culture and in teaching materials. They work to develop the skills not only to recognize the dominant narrative, but to counter and enrich it. They bring multiple perspectives into the classroom and openly discuss past and present injustices as well as the ways people have worked together to correct them. They avoid one-dimensional characterizations of historical figures and groups, including those that cast oppressed people as faceless victims or national leaders as flawless. —From *antiracistfuture.org*
