More than 150 pieces of legislation targeting queer and trans people have been introduced in state legislatures across the country (ACLU, 2022). These bills currently exist in 31 states, and this threatens the future for individuals in the community nationwide.

While anti-LGBTGEQIAP+ legislation is not a new phenomenon, the state level attack against equality follows a number of improvements at the federal level. These attacks place transgender, non-binary, and other gender non-conforming youth amongst the most targeted groups at this time.
