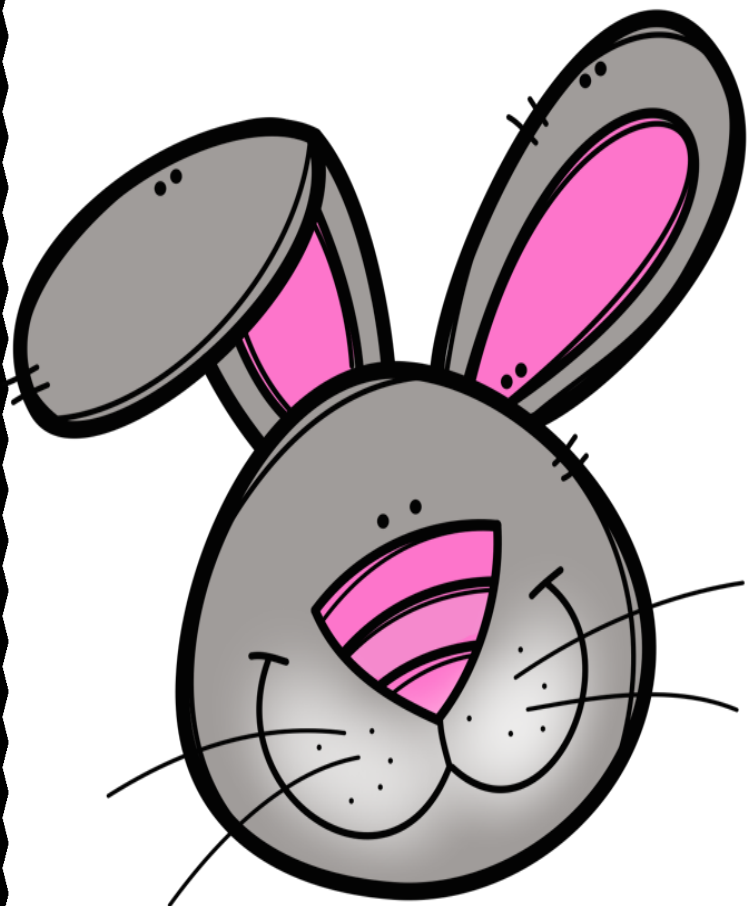


Rabbit Syllable Division

z**i**p**p**ing

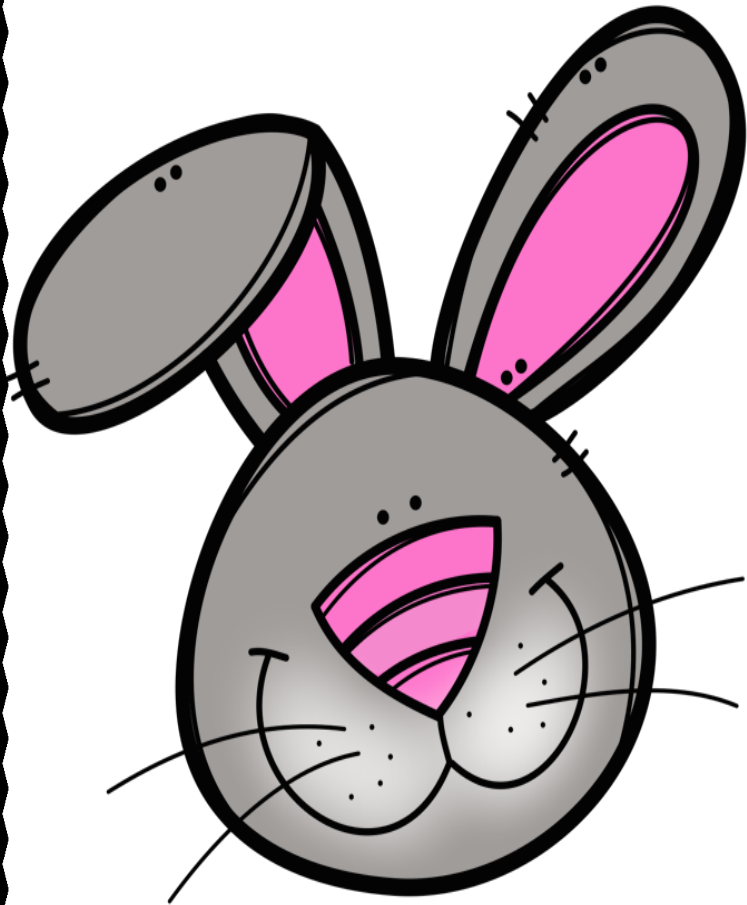

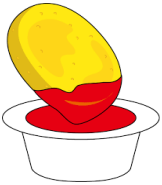
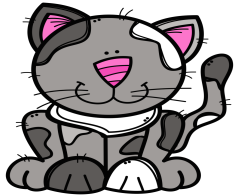

Rabbit



Rabbit words are words with two syllables. They have two consonants between two vowels. **VC*CV** You can listen for each syllable. Write the first part. Write the second part. Then write the BIG word.



The **rabbit** went down the path. He was **hopping**.

I like to play **tennis** with mom and dad.

Can you see the **biggest** fish in the pond?

All of a **sudden** the **hobbit** got **bitten**.

The **kitten** is white as my **mitten**. It is the **biggest kitten**. It can purr. The **kitten** is **smitten** with me. It is **ripping** the cloth with its paws!
Stop **kitten**! Stop!!
