Saying Goodbye to Dr. Cole

Dr. Eddie R. Cole, Associate Professor of Higher Education, has taken a new position at UCLA. Dr. Cole joined the William & Mary faculty in 2013 after being a research project associate for the Indiana University Center for Postsecondary Research. During his tenure at William & Mary, Dr. Cole received the Early Career Award from the Association for the Study of Higher Education, was named a 2017 Nancy Weiss Malkiel Scholar of the Woodrow Wilson National Fellowship Foundation, and was recognized as a 2015 National Academy of Education/Spencer Foundation Postdoctoral Fellow. Dr. Cole has also received research fellowships and grants from Princeton University, the University of Chicago and the University of Wisconsin-Madison, and has delivered invited talks at Harvard University, Duke University and Teachers College, Columbia University. He has been an engaging and provocative professor and a supportive colleague. We will miss having Dr. Cole at William & Mary, but are excited to see what accomplishments are to come!
