This special permit will be handed to class participants ONLY on class day as you arrive for class (no advance requests) and is ONLY available to class participants who enter the campus at the Richmond Road & Scotland Street entrance State-issued ADA placard/plate PLUS 26-27 Osher parking hang tag allows parking in any handicapped or Faculty/Staff space on campus Paid City/CW parking using Passport app OR off-campus street parking where allowed

Handicapped	The Nursery/Greenhouse Complex is accessible via the driveway to the McCormack-Nagelsen Tennis Center at 807 S Henry Street (just south of the W&M Law School). Parking is available near the Greenhouse; follow the main Tennis Center drive beyond and behind (south) of the large green Tennis Center building Park in the same location as described above for the for the 26-27 Osher permit (#1), which is the close to the greenhouse. Wear sturdy shoes; the path from the parking lot to the greenhouse is unpaved gravel

Park On Your Own	N/A; there is no Osher class parking in Hunt Circle or the Facility/Maintenance Lot EXCEPT for Handicapped parking (see #2 next) or when visiting the Osher Office (see 'On Campus Office' at the bottom of this page) State-issued ADA placard/plate PLUS 26-27 Osher parking hang tag allows parking in any handicapped or Faculty/Staff space on campus Paid parking in Colonial Williamsburg P2, P4, P5, P6 lots & Prince George Garage using the Passport app. Free parking may be available on City streets where allowed, along Richmond Road, or at the Williamsburg Regional Library
School of Education 301 Monticello Ave	1. 26-27 Osher Permit 2. Handicapped	Convenient parking at the School of Education in Student Lots 1, 2, 4, 5 State-issued ADA placard/plate PLUS 26-27 Osher parking hang tag allows parking in any handicapped or Faculty/Staff space on campus
Swem Library 400 Landrum Dr	1. 26-27 Osher Permit 2. Handicapped 3. Park On Your Own	N/A. No Osher class parking at Swem; no free parking in Ukrop Parking Deck State-issued ADA placard/plate PLUS 26-27 Osher parking hang tag allows parking in any handicapped or Faculty/Staff space on campus Paid parking in Swem Passport spaces and at the Ukrop Parking Deck (also Passport)

Williamsburg Regional Library	515 Scotland St (Downtown Williamsburg)	Free surface lot & street parking; may be full at peak times; paid public parking nearby in City garage

Osher Office Campus Center 104 Jamestown Rd Suite 203 (2nd Floor)	Visitors to the Osher Office: We've moved to Campus Center, Ste 203. When visiting us, you may park in one of the Hunt spaces marked "1-Hour." The small Hunt Circle lot is located off of S Boundary Street at the rear entrance to Campus Center. Obey all signage; this lot is routinely checked for compliance. Be sure to ask the Osher staff for a printed and dated validation stamp to present to Parking Services should you be ticketed while visiting the office and parked in a Hunt Lot 1-hour space. Office hours are 10am-3pm. However, the team is often out of the office setting up classes & may not be immediately available by phone or in person. Email to osher@wm.edu will usually elicit quicker response , as we are unable to listen to voicemail messages until we return to the office
