- Passport application/renewal fees (*if applicable*)

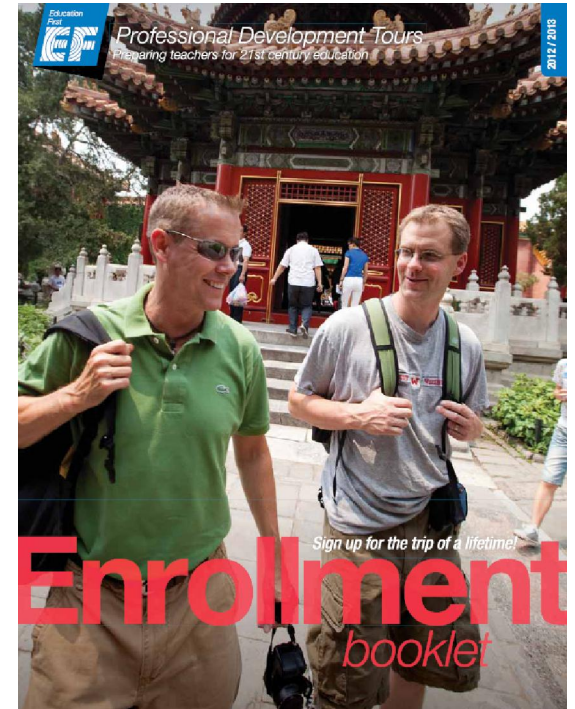

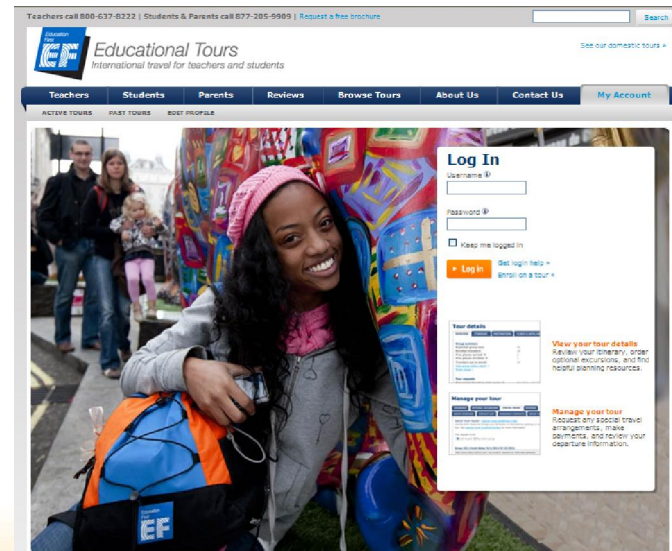
