

Stipends to Support Visits to Co-Teaching Demonstration Sites in Regions 2 and 3

The Virginia Department of Education (VDOE) has identified Co-Teaching Demonstration sites throughout the Commonwealth in the Excellence in Co-Teaching Initiative. There are eleven demonstration sites locally in Superintendents Regions 2 and 3. These model sites provide opportunities for co-teaching partners across the state to observe effective co-teaching. The sites highlight research-based inclusive practices to meet the needs of all students within the general education classroom. At each model site, the co-teaching teams share with visitors co-planning, co-instructing, and co-assessing practices that have helped their students succeed.

Stipend Details

T/TAC College of William and Mary (W&M) is offering stipends to defray costs associated with visits to Co-Teaching Demonstration sites in Superintendent's Regions 2 and 3. Schools are encouraged to send teams that include co-teaching partners (a general education and special education teacher) and an administrator.

Stipends will be awarded in the amount of \$800 per team if overnight travel is necessary, or \$250 per team if overnight travel is not needed. Schools must pay their expenses related to this initiative upfront. Funds will not be released to school divisions until 30 days **after** the visit and completion of all required follow-up paperwork. If multiple teams from the same school attend, only one payment will be issued to the school after all teams complete the requirements.

T/TAC W&M will work with our Co-Teaching Demonstration sites to arrange a visit at a site that most closely matches your team's grade level. You will be contacted regarding your award status and scheduling details within one week of application completion.
