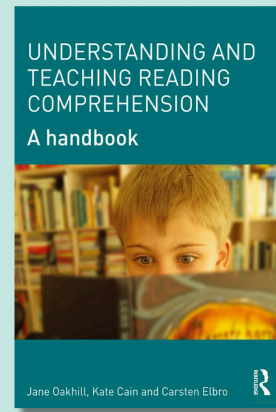
Asynchronous Book Study Opportunity
