This scholarship award can only be given to an individual once.

In 1988, the Faculty established the School of Education Award for Excellence to be awarded to two meritorious graduate students: one a Master's candidate and the other an Educational Specialist or Doctoral candidate. In 1989, the Faculty added a third award for excellence to recognize an undergraduate student. All three awards are funded by contributions from alumni, faculty and friends to the School of Education Annual Fund. In 2004, the Faculty changed the eligibility for the Master's candidate recipient to include Educational Specialist.

The sole purpose of these awards is to bestow on the recipients recognition as outstanding students in education. The fellowships are designed to recognize academic and professional excellence, as well as citizenship. The individuals selected must be of exemplary status at their degree level. This award can only be awarded to an individual once. Undergraduates and both part-time and full-time graduate students are eligible for consideration, and both graduate recipients may be from the same program of studies. The individual must be eligible to participate in the May Commencement ceremony.
